Glen Ridge Drive Stormwater Project

Public works crews are currently working to replace, realign, and expand an older stormwater system on Glen Ridge Drive.

Modern pipes and connections will replace the outdated corrugated metal pipes which are subject to rusting over time. The project is expected to dramatically improve stormwater conveyance in the neighborhood. The township is currently finalizing a Storm Sewer Condition Assessment to help prioritize future projects like this one.

Only scammers demand payment in cryptocurrency.



SCAM ALERT!

Cryptocurrency Scams are on the rise. Scammers are impersonating well-known companies.

They'll text, call, email, or send messages on social media — or maybe put a pop-up alert on your computer. They might say there's

fraud on your account, or your money is at risk — and to fix it, you need to deposit cryptocurrency and send it to them, or they may offer to send you a check to deposit. DO NOT DO THIS...it's a scam. It's just that simple. Only scammers ask you to pay fees, back taxes, or bills for services through bitcoin (cryptocurrency).

Falling victim to a cryptocurrency scam can be devastating, and it's essential to act quickly. If you feel you have been a victim of a scammer, contact your bank immediately. Visit the Federal Trade Commission's website for more information at ftc.gov/cryptocurrency
